

Remember “Gustar” (to be pleasing to) / (to like)?

Personal “a” clarifying phrases are optional!

- [A mí]

Use “gusta” when the thing you like is singular, or if it is a verb!

me gusta(n)

Use “gustan” when the thing you like is plural!

nos gusta(n)

- [A nosotros]
- [A Juan y a mí]

- [A ti]

te gusta(n)

- [A Vosotros]
- [A Juan y a ti]

os gusta(n)

- [A él] / [A Juan]
- [A ella] / [A Luisa]
- [A Ud.]


le gusta(n)

- [A ellos] / [A Juan y a Jessica]
- [A ellas] / [A Kim y a Marta]
- [A Uds.]


les gusta(n)

“Encantar” (to love) works the same way!


Personal “a” clarifying phrases are optional!



Use “encanta” when the thing you love is singular, or if it is a verb!



Use “encantan” when the thing you love is plural!

me encanta(n)

• [A nosotros]

nos encanta(n)

• [A Juan y a mí]

• [A ti]

te encanta(n)

• [A Vosotros]

os encanta(n)

• [A Juan y a ti]

• [A él] / [A Juan]

• [A ella] / [A Luisa] le encanta(n)

• [A Ud.]

• [A ellos] /
[A Juan y a Jessica]

• [A ellas] /
[A Kim y a Marta] les encanta(n)

Some Examples w/ “Encantar”

Singular Objects & Verbs

- Me encanta dormir.
 - I love to sleep.
- ¿Te encanta dibujar?
 - Do you love to draw?
- A Jorge, le encanta la pizza.
 - Jorge loves pizza.
- A Sofia y a Nora, les encanta el arte.
 - Sofia and Nora love art.

Plural Objects

- Me encantan las fresas.
 - I love strawberries.
- A Clara, le encantan los libros de Harry Potter
 - Clara loves Harry Potter books
- Nos encantan las donas.
 - We love donuts.
