

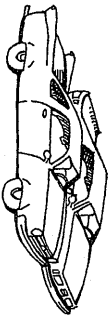

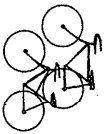
To compare two things or people in Spanish use the following:

**más + adjective + que.**  
(more \_\_\_\_\_ than)

**ejemplo:** Antonio es **más alto que** Pablo.  
(Antonio is taller than Pablo.)

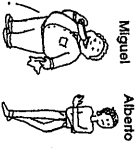


**Note:** Remember that adjectives must agree in gender and number with the nouns they modify.

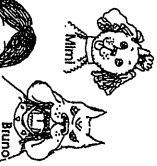


**ejemplos:** Ana es **más alta que** María.  
Los carros son **más grandes que** las bicicletas.

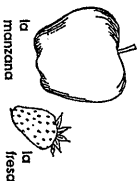

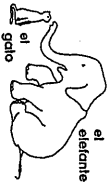

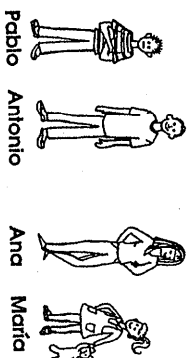

Another way to compare two people or things is to use:

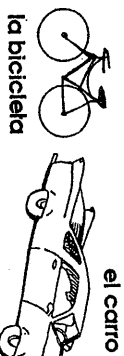
**menos + adjective + que.**  
(less \_\_\_\_\_ than)

**ejemplos:** Pablo es **menos alto que** Antonio.  
(Pablo is less tall than Antonio.)

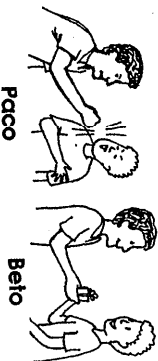
María es **menos alta que** María.



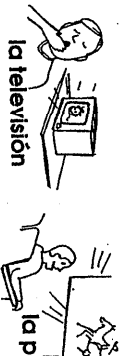

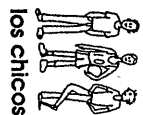

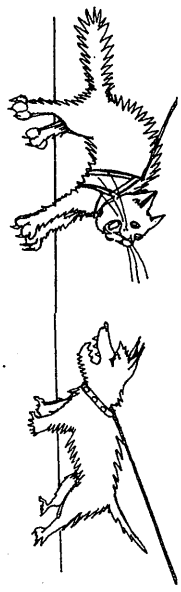
You can compare things that are equal by using the expression:

(as \_\_\_\_\_ as)



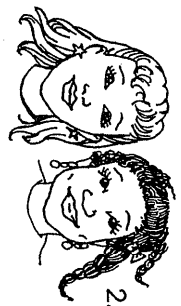
**ejemplo:** El español es **tan** importante **como** el inglés.

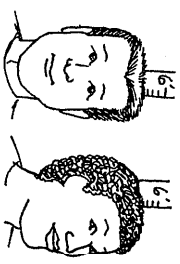
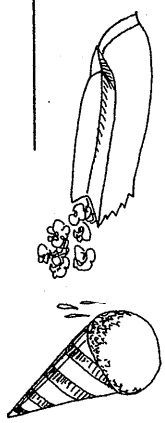

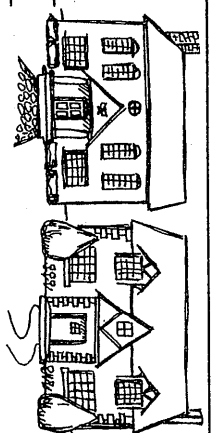
