

Los pronombres Pronouns

A **subject pronoun** is a word used to replace the proper name of a subject in a sentence.

Example: Jane is running. — She is running.
 "She" is the pronoun used in place of "Jane."

Here are the subject pronouns in Spanish.

Pronombres personales

Singulares

yo I
 tú you (informal)
 usted (Ud.) you (formal)
 él he/it (masculine)
 ella she/it (feminine)

Plurales

nosotros/nosotras we (masculine/feminine)
 vosotros/vosotras you (plural, informal) *
 ustedes (Uds.) you (plural, informal or formal)
 ellos/ellas they (masculine/feminine)
 * Note that vosotros is used only in Spain.

As the chart shows, there are many ways to say "you" in Spanish.
 To say "you" referring to one person, use tú or usted.
 To say "you" referring to more than one person, use vosotros or ustedes.
